Principal's Comment

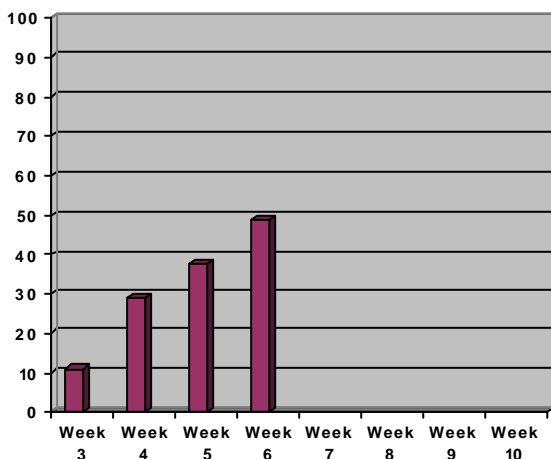
Congratulations to our swimming representatives at the Regional PSSA Carnival and a special congratulations to Riley Briggs who won his event and will now compete in Sydney in April.
