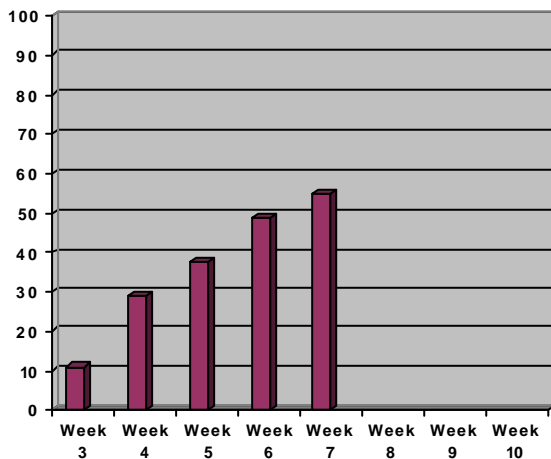
Principal's Comment
