Great Space Shuttle Atlantis views.

Excellent views of the Space Shuttle are there for the taking most evenings this week. The shuttle is up there to make repairs on the Hubble Space Telescope and is easily visible to the naked eye. It is even better with binoculars. The table below details when and where to look. The first opportunity to see it is at 6.39 PM tonight, in the northern sky, 10 degrees above the horizon.
