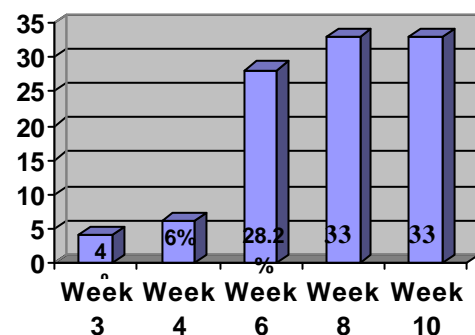
Commiserations to the girls Cricket team who were defeated by Edward Public School from Deniliquin yesterday. The team tried hard and were gallant in defeat.

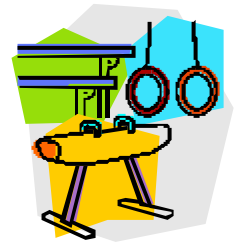

Keep a look out for future fundraising events, as the P&C focuses on fresh priorities and resources for the school, now the air-conditioning is being installed.

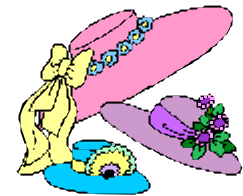

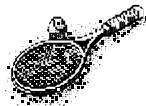

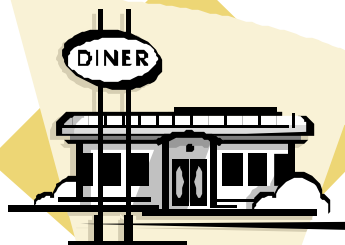
