LAUNCH PAD

"Launch Pad" is a touring performance show that features performers who've been involved in the NSW DET Schools Spectacular and also the NSW DET Talent Development Project. The show has been touring throughout schools in NSW for the last 5 years (excluding 2008). In that time a forever changing line up of performers, all of which have come from NSW public schools have entertained and educated thousands of kids.

The show is very entertaining for the students as well as focusing on introducing and developing musical concepts such as harmony and rhythm in a fun interactive way.

Over the five years, "Launch Pad" has received acclaim and endorsement from school staff and students alike as well as high profile figures Mary Lopez (Director of the NSW DET Schools Spectacular) and broadcast personality Alan Jones.

This year the Riverina is a big focus for "Launch Pad", as the performers are past country kids.

This year the show will feature founder of Launch Pad Clint Crighton, who will be featured on ABCs "Live at the Basement" series this season, Clint has performed throughout the world alongside many world renown musicians, he will be returning to the USA in late August where he is set to play shows with Grammy award winner Sheryl Crow. Clint is joined by Newcastle singer/songwriter performer Jules. Jules has performed throughout the USA, China and Australia, has been featured in the NSW DET Schools Spectacular and Newcastle's Starstruck. The third performer is TBA.

The cost has remained the same for the last four years and is \$5 per student and \$10/Family (2+). The show runs for around 60-70minutes.

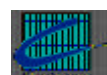
