Could your child be suffering from an undetected vision problem?

Does your child constantly squint or rub their eyes, complain of headaches, have trouble concentrating or holds their book very close when reading?

If so your child could be one in four of Australian children who suffer from an undetected vision problem.

The earlier and more regularly your children's eyes are examined, the better the prospects for successful treatment. Parents are recommended that their children's eyes be examined at six months of age, three years old and before starting school. During school years age an examination every two years is recommended. Eye examinations are covered under Medicare and more than 95 per cent of optometric services are bulk billed.

The Optometrists Association Australia has developed a concise checklist to help parents recognise possible vision problems in their children, as well as tips on television watching, reading, the use of video games and UV protection.
